# Terms and conditions for playing squash at Brackley Squash Club during Phase 2 opening

In line with Government and England Squash guidelines relating to the CoVid-19 pandemic, Brackley Squash Club will reopen with limited playing **but only to members who are prepared to accept the T&Cs, risks and obligations** outlined below.

In summary there are three key things you need to remember:-

- 1. Book all people who will be in the club (track and trace)
- 2. Arrive prepared to play
- 3. Clean up and get out on time

Currently, it is not possible for any member to book a court but we are putting everything in place for 1st September.

The Committee have reviewed England Squash guidelines on re-opening and have followed all steps that are practical for our Club. However, because the courts are not supervised, the Committee cannot implement all the recommendations, therefore we have minimized the risk where feasible. We are reliant on members to take on board the risk of visiting and to confirm that they will abide by the obligations detailed below.

Key steps that the Club have implemented as part of Phase 1 of 4

- A risk assessment has been undertaken
- Only 1 court can now be booked at a time, 40 minutes play on court play time
- Ventilation of the courts between games with constant use of the fans
- Camera recording of courts will ensure timing is met by members leaving/joining the court. The committee will review the footage.
- Signs, hand sanitisers and sanitising wipes, disinfectant cleaner for high touch points are now in place
- All common touch points have been sanitised
- Member obligations have been communicated
- The club will be cleaned 3 times per day during the week and once a day at the weekend by professional cleaners

## Your responsibilities

As a booking member you accept and acknowledge the risk of visiting.

Brackley Squash Club cannot be held responsible in case of any infection that may have been caught while you use the club.

In line with the new track and trace membership requirement from Richard Neat, (membership secretary) ensure that you have read the obligations below.

On receipt of your track and trace reset of your membership we will ensure that you are given access to the BSC Court booking system.

- You are only allowed to play squash either solo or with one other club member or with up to 4 members of your household or 'bubble'
- If you play with a member not in your bubble you must follow the England Squash social distancing advice available <u>here</u>.
- All players must be named on all bookings camera video recording on both courts will ensure compliance, failure to do so to keep in line with our track and trace requirement will make your membership inactive for 14 days.
- No visitors or guests to the Club until further notice.
- No play is allowed without prior booking failure to adhere to this will result in loss of membership.

RISK: as per England Squash guidelines, in an enclosed court there is a limited risk of the CoVid-19 virus could be remaining airborne if it entered the club. Therefore, even with gaps between games, there is some risk associated with a visit to the club. The Committee want all members to acknowledge and consider this risk before they decide to visit the club. (See BSC website for further England Squash guideline information via the home page)

Obligations for all visitors to Brackley Squash Club until further notice

- If you have had any contact with someone who has had suspected or confirmed CoVid-19 in the last 2 weeks, then you must self-isolate for 14 days and not visit the club.
- Any member / player who has recovered from a CoVid-19 infection which required hospital treatment must consult their Doctor before returning to play .
- If you feel unwell or that you might have any COVID-19 symptoms (the most common ones are a recent onset of a new continuous cough or high temperature or a loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell) then you must not visit the club. You should not leave your house for at least 10 days from when your symptoms started (if you live alone), or 14 days (if you live with someone who has symptoms).
- If you have visited the court in last 14 days and then feel unwell or develop potential COVID symptoms, as well as notifying any national or local 'track and trace' bodies, please notify the club immediately (with details of when you played, the name of any playing partner or other persons you encountered on your visit) by calling/texting

# Before Play

- You must arrive dressed to play no earlier than 10 minutes before your session start time and leave straight after your game finishes, sanitise the common touch points within 10 minutes after your 40 min game.
- The shower facilities are out of bounds as is the upstairs area
- Do not share any equipment, including racquets, water bottles will be provided as the water fountain is out of use until further notice.

Before any play on arrival each member should test the opposing player's temperature with the infrared thermometer forehead check provided by the noticeboard on the stand.

- Press trigger to switch on,
- place gun approx 50mm away from the forehead press the button.
- Green is OK
- Amber or Red with a high temperature please leave the club immediately, seek medical assistance and advise the CoVid-19 subcommittee below.
- Clean gun after use with a sanitizer wipe for the next user.

### **During Play**

Do not wipe your hands on the walls and avoid all unnecessary contact where possible If with a person not in your bubble follow ES advice <u>here</u>.

## After Play

#### Finish no later that quarter to the hour

On departure, members must use a sanitising wipe to sanitise all touch points they may have used, including any of those listed below. Remember at weekends there is only one clean per day.

- Court areas you have touched which could leave a residue (e.g. hands, skin etc.)
- Court door push points (external side) and handle (inside)
- Bottom of the stairs
- Toilet door, flush and taps
- Light meter
- Light switch
- Door keypad
- Front door handles inc exit doors

Hand sanitisers are available at all key points of entry/exit.

Sanitising wipes have been made available by the noticeboard and should be **disposed of in the bin.** 

Safety of all of our members is paramount and a full track & trace facility is needed to keep members safe during these unprecedented times.
